- Ensure that all sections of the application have been completed and received at the office by the closing date;
- Be undertaking an undergraduate, postgraduate, or diploma programme (Level 5-10 courses of study);
- Be undertaking study within New Zealand that provides recognised NZQA programmes;
- Be undertaking programmes in the fields of study that are identified below;
- This form is the official application. Facsimiles, scans or emails of the form will be accepted.
- Applications close Thursday 30 March 2023. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

### NOTE:

- All decisions are final, there is no review process available;
- All decisions made in relation to scholarships are based on the Wairarapa Moana strategic plan and scholarship policy. Applicants who will contribute towards the vision of the strategic plan will be a priority.
